Grandcamp Les Bains: Cleared through Yerville sur Mer & adv 6 miles toward Grandcamp Les Bains. A coordinated shelling with naval, tank, and mortar support virtually demolished sections of the town. Many prisoners were taken when town was cleared at 2300 hrs. Camped for night 300 yards outside of city. (Pointe du Hoc was taken while enroute)
