PART A

1. When the remains are delivered for interment in a civilian or private cemetery, you are responsible for paying all interment expenses. In this connection, you are entitled to the allowance mentioned in paragraph 2 below.

2. An amount not to exceed \$75 is allowed by the Government toward actual interment expenses when final interment of the remains is in a private or civilian cemetery. No allowance is authorized toward interment expenses when interment is in a national or post cemetery.

3. The \$75 maximum allowance by the Government toward interment expenses includes but is not limited to the payment of one or more of the following items: Hearse hire from the railroad station to your home, the funeral home, church, cemetery, or any other place designated by you; vault; church services; newspaper notices; transportation for friends and relatives to and from cemetery; and the services of a funeral director.

4. Reimbursement by the Government is made only to the person who paid from his personal funds the expenses of or incident to interment in a private or civilian cemetery. Receipted bills are not required to accompany this form. Any expenses over and above the \$75 maximum must be borne by the person who incurred or paid the additional expenses.

PART B

1. When the remains are delivered to you at Government expense prior to burial in a national or post cemetery, you are responsible for all additional expenses necessary to deliver the remains from that point to the national or post cemetery grave site. However, you may be entitled to an allowance for the cost of transporting the remains from your home to the national or post cemetery grave site subject to the conditions outlined in paragraph 2 below.

2. Reimbursement of transportation expenses is allowed only when the cost to the Government to deliver the remains to you is LESS than what it would have cost the Government to deliver the remains direct to the national or post cemetery of final interment. However, the amount which you may be allowed (the difference between cost of delivery to you and cost of delivery by the Government direct to the national or post cemetery) may not exceed the amount actually expended by you to deliver the remains to the cemetery grave site. **WHETHER OR NOT YOU WILL BE GRANTED AN ALLOWANCE IS DEPENDENT UPON AN AUDIT OF THIS REQUEST. IN ANY EVENT YOU WILL BE NOTIFIED OF ANY ALLOWANCE DUE YOU BY THE OFFICE TO WHICH THIS FORM IS SENT.**

3. Reimbursement by the Government will be made only to the person who paid from his personal funds for transporting the remains to the national or post cemetery grave site.

My dear Sir:

On December 22nd you addressed a letter to Mrs. Betty Jo Evers, Millgrove, Indiana, with respect to the personal effects of her deceased husband Second Lieutenant Lloyd M. Evers. In that letter you referred to an indebtedness of her husband to Pvt. Ernest Hebert in the amount of \$100.00 and enclosed copies of two affidavits.

I write this letter for Mrs. Evers in my capacity as service officer of the local post of the American Legion.

If Mrs. Evers' husband was indebted to this enlisted man in any manner or in any amount, she, of course, will see that it is repaid, and intends to do so. However, she does not feel warranted in making this repayment merely upon a statement of a man about whom she never heard before, even though his statement may be sworn to. Neither do I feel warranted in advising her as service officer to pay Pvt. Hebert \$100.00 merely upon his sworn statement this transaction took place.

If a confidential inquiry with respect to the reputation of Pvt. Hebert, and his verifying witness, for honesty and fair dealing, and truth and veracity, in their home communities could be obtained, Mrs. Evers is more than willing to rely upon his statement and that of his verifying witness. If, therefore, you would furnish us with the home address of Pvt. Hebert and of Pvt. Van K. Gourley, together with the names of their parent or parents or wives, if married, as shown by the Army's records, I will have a confidential inquiry made in their home communities with respect to their reputations for honesty and fair dealing and truth and veracity through American Legion, Bank or other confidential channels. If their records show clean back home in these respects Mrs. Evers will then promptly communicate with Pvt. Hebert as you suggest in your letter.


