1. a. See Annex No. 1 Intelligence

b. (1) Seaborne elements of VII Corps land on "U" Beach at H-Hour, column of Divs, 4th Div leading; capture CHERBOURG. 1st A/B Div lands between STE MERE - EGLISE (349965) and CARENTAN (395845) assaults the western exits of the CAUSEWAYS to assist the landing of the seaborne elements and cover the crossings of the DOUVE from the junction of the MERDERET to the sea. The 4th Div atks to the NORTH WEST, passing thru the A/B Divs.

(2) 82d A/B Div (less Dets) lands by prcht and glider before and after dawn of D-Day astride the MERDERET RIVER, seizes, clears, and secures the area indicated on overlay "Friendly Troops" Annex 1 b (3); protects the NORTHWEST flank of the VII Corps within the Div zone; be prepared to advance WEST, on order, to the line of the DOUVE, NORTH of its junction with the PRAIRIES MARECAGEUSES.

2. This regiment (less seaborne detachments) will land by gliders in LZ W in accordance with Annex No 2 Air Movement Table, assemble in Div Reserve in the area indicated, be prepared to assist in clearing the Div area of hostile resistance, to counterattack within the Div area and to advance WEST to the DOUVE on Div order.

3. a. (1) 1st Bn will land in LZ W, clear, organize and defend the LZ during the landing of the regiment.

(2) Cover the rear of the regiment during movement to the assembly area.

(3) On order, move to assembly area, priority of routes to other units of the regiment, organize defense of Bn sector of assembly area.

(4) Reconnoiter sector indicated, prepare plans to counterattack, or to reinforce or relieve units in its sector.

(5) Prepare plans to move as advance guard of the regiment to the DOUVE RIVER, in the vicinity of ST SAVEUR LE VICOMTE. Route - Defense area 507th, high ground WEST to ST SAVEUR LE VICOMTE.
