RECORD OF EVENTS

24 Oct/44 Remained in Bn reserve area. Br. rations. Moved out at 2000 hrs with weapons and entrenching tools and began digging positions for a secondary defensive line. Weather cool. Morale good.

25 Oct/44 Returned from preparing secondary defensive positions at 0215 hrs. Remained in Bn Reserve area. Br. Rations. Moved out at 2200 hrs to continue work on secondary positions. Weather slightly warmer. Morale good.

26 Oct/44 Returned fr completing secondary positions at 0210 hrs. (OVER)
