*During our crossing over the Channel I and the rest of the stick sweated out and expected anything to happen as I and some of the men in the stick had jumped in Sicily and Italy. I was leading the stick out and kept the men's moral up as much as I could.*

What were the rumors on board the boat, ship or plane in which you made the crossing? (Some people remember scuttlebut to the effect that the Germans had poured gasoline on the water and planned to set it afire when the troops came in).

*The only rumors I heard was we were jumping somewhere in France (Normandy) expected something worse than Sicily and Italy jump.*

Did you by any chance keep a diary of what happened to you that day?

*No*

Were any of your friends killed or wounded either during the landing or during the day?

*Yes, but can't re-call their names*

Do you remember any conversations you had with them before they became casualties?

*all I can recall is giving them orders as their Squad leader.*

Were you wounded? *Yes, in Sicily and Holland*

Do you remember what it was like--that is, do you remember whether you felt any pain or were you so surprised that you felt nothing?

*Both times I was surprised and felt no pain until I was in the hospital.*

Do you remember seeing or hearing anything that seems funny now, even though it did not, of course, seem amusing at the time?

*To me everything we did was serious and never joked about anything.*

Do you recall any incident, sad or heroic, or simply memorable, which struck you more than anything else?

*When advancing Rhine River and I lead the company at mid night and was so dark we couldn't see our hands in front of our face, my company commander was Captain Martin.*

This will not be another strategic history, but the story of the twenty-four hours of invasion day as individuals lived them and remember them. For this we must find the men who were there and, if they are willing, invade their memories. The story of the 82nd Airborne is obviously among the proudest, and therefore we were delighted to learn from General Gavin that someone is keeping a Company news sheet.
