b. Unknown X-68 : (Clothing mark T-5218) Identified as Travers, Thomas J., 12 065 218 by comparison with identification tag with clothing mark.

c. Unknown X-69 : (Body partially burned) After eliminating X-68 and X-67 the remaining unidentified were X-65 and X-69. Of the two remaining identification tags, Reeves and Rushing, the tag of Rushing showed definite evidence of having been burned where as no such evidence showed on the tag of Reeves by which evidence was used in identifying X-69 as Rushing, Jesse J.

d. Unknown X-67 : (Clothing marks H-3888) Identified as Humphries, Shuford N., 34 123 888 by comparison with identification tag with clothing mark.

The people of the United States, through the Congress have authorized the disinterment and final burial of the heroic dead of World War II. The Quartermaster General of the Army has been entrusted with this sacred responsibility to the honored dead. The records of the War Department indicate that you may be the nearest relative of the above-named deceased, who gave his life in the service of his country.

The enclosed pamphlets, "Disposition of World War II Armed Forces Dead," and "American Cemeteries," explain the disposition, options and services made available to you by your Government. If you are the next of kin according to the line of kinship as set forth in the enclosed pamphlet, "Disposition of World War II Armed Forces Dead," you are invited to express your wishes as to the disposition of the remains of the deceased by completing Part I of the enclosed form "Request for Disposition of Remains." Should you desire to relinquish your rights to the next in line of kinship, please complete Part II of the enclosed form. If you are not the next of kin, please complete Part III of the enclosed form.

If you should elect Option 2, it is advised that no funeral arrangements or other personal arrangements be made until you are further notified by this office.

Will you please complete the enclosed form, "Request for Disposition of Remains" and mail in the enclosed self-addressed envelope, which requires no postage, within 30 days after its receipt by you? Its prompt return will avoid unnecessary delays.

Dear Mrs. Holton:

Your letter concerning your son, the late Private Jesse J. Rushing, has been received in this office.

The War Department has now been authorized to remove, at Government expense, to the final resting place designated by the next of kin, the remains of those American citizens who died while serving overseas with our armed forces during this war.

When the necessary preliminaries have been completed, a "Letter of Inquiry — Return of World War II Dead" will be sent to the next of kin of those American dead. The response to this letter will constitute a formal expression of the next of kin's detailed desires. Since letters to next of kin will be dispatched automatically and according to the records here, communications with this office regarding this subject will not be necessary. The necessity for complete coordination of movement in many parts of the world makes it impossible, at this time, to estimate when this letter will be mailed. Responses to these letters will be acted upon with a minimum of delay.

The marriage license forwarded in your letter concerning the remarriage of your son's widow is not considered sufficient evidence of her remarriage by this office.

It is therefore requested that an authenticated copy or transcript of the marriage of record in the state of Colorado issued by a public official showing that the marriage is a matter of record in his office be furnished. Upon receipt of this certificate, the records of this office will be properly amended to show the person authorized to determine the final disposition of your son's remains.

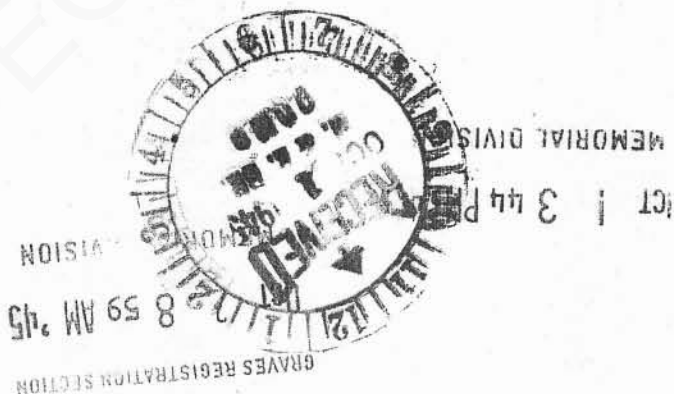

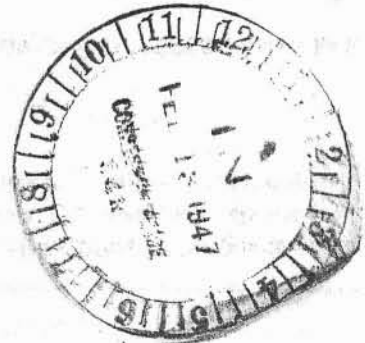

1. We enclose eight (8) dog tags, a New Testament and miscellaneous papers and a cigarette lighter which have today been handed to us by a civilian.

2. The tags and papers, etc., were removed from the bodies of eight (8) American soldiers, seven (7) enlisted men and an officer from whose body the Testament and other papers were removed.

3. The civilian tells us that these soldiers were Parachutists who landed at Graignes, the bodies being removed by civilians from water close by the Church at that place on June 11, 1944. Shortly after the bodies had been removed the civilian population had to be evacuated, and have only just returned to find that the bodies had been removed.

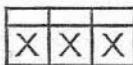
