RECORD OF EVENTS:

7 Jun 44: Left Spanhoe Field at 2300 hr for operation Neptune, dropped at 0205 hr. Co Landed approx 3 mi fr Ste Mere Eglise, France. Assembled about 0300 & went into action at bridge No 1 at 100 hr. Stayed in action around bridge until 1100 hr 8 Jun 44.

8 Jun 44: Co Moved fr front line 1000 hr and traveled by foot to a reorganizing area 2½ miles west of Ste Mere Eglise. Spent remainder of day cleaning weapons & checking equip.

9 Jun 44: Co Left Bivouac area at 0430 hr 9 Jun 44. Went into division reserve following line of battle until 1800 hr, then ~~23~~ went to the front. Relieved the 325th Glider Inf & dug into positions.

26 Jun 44: 2 O's & 10 EM VIA France
6 June 44.
