

June 9/44 company attacked the enemy at 0600. Withdrew at 2330 and went in to position on left flank of regiment. June 10, 1944 Company in reserve. Patrols were sent out. June 11/44 Company on right flank in battalion attack. Casualties heavy. Took the town of LeHam. Captured several prisoners. June 14/44 company started attack west towards Morderet river. Met fairly stiff resistance. Continued attack on June 15/44. June 26/44 company still on airborne mission.
