- 11 June 44: Co still in defensive position. Moved to position of road 1 mi SE of Chauville into defensive position, covering wide area.
- 12 June 44: Co still in defensive position sending out patrols & holding ground. 1 FM wounded by snipers late in afternoon. Weather: Fair; Morale: good.
- 13 June 44: Co moved out of defensive position being relieved by 30 Inf and moved to bivouac area 2 1/2 mi SE of Entenville.
- 14 June 44: Co in bivouac Co was alerted to move out at 1700 hr. Co moved out at 2300 hr marched to new bivouac area Location see new coordinates 163303.
- 15 June 44: Co in regt reserve.
- 16 June 44: Co moved into defensive position Co was in 163302 fr defensive position. 1st plat went into attack 1 C & 1 FM were WIA.
- 17 June 44: Co attacked fr position of Ste Sauveur Le Vicomte & moved to position 170942. Captured 7 prisoners killing 10 and capturing one 38 ^{mm}, 1 jeep, 1 half-track and took up defensive position 170942. *in*
- 18 June 44: Co was in defensive position & is now on an alert status.
- 19 June 44: Co was on the alert to move out. Co moved out at 1100hr to forward area. Co was on alert to move & moved by truck. Traveled 12 mi road good present location 163303. Morale fair now in regt'l assembly area.
- 20 June 44: Co was in regt'l assy area. Co moved out by Bn to present position. In a defensive position. Sending out road blocks and patrols.
- 21 June 44: Co in defensive position sending out patrols & holding road blocks. Coordinated 163706.
