RECORD OF EVENTS

Forward Echelon: 11 June/44. Btry in position and fired 524 rds of ammunition. Area strafed at 1500 hrs by 2 M3 109's - one plane was knocked down. Lt Stewart joined battery after being behind enemy lines for six days, Chaplain Reid held services in battery area, Moral excellent.

Base Echelon: 11 June/44. Usual camp duties.
