behind prearranged schedule. Each section came under small arms, MG, & mortar fire while disembarking. Co had to wade through approximately 30 yds of water while fired upon by the enemy. Co was engaged in a fire fight with enemy strong points overlooking the beach for about 6 hours. 3 Sections were landed in 3rd Bn Sector where they aided in knocking out enemy beach defences. The surviving men remained with 3rd Bn & rejoined Co the following day. At 1230 hrs remainder of Co not with 3rd Bn was ordered to move 500 yds to the right where a break through had been established. Bn moved inland near Colleville. The Co because of loss of officers & in the process of reorganization remained with Bn furnished furnishing local security. The officers & BM showed extreme courage & bravery while crossing the beach, aiding the wounded under fire & assaulting pillboxes even though
