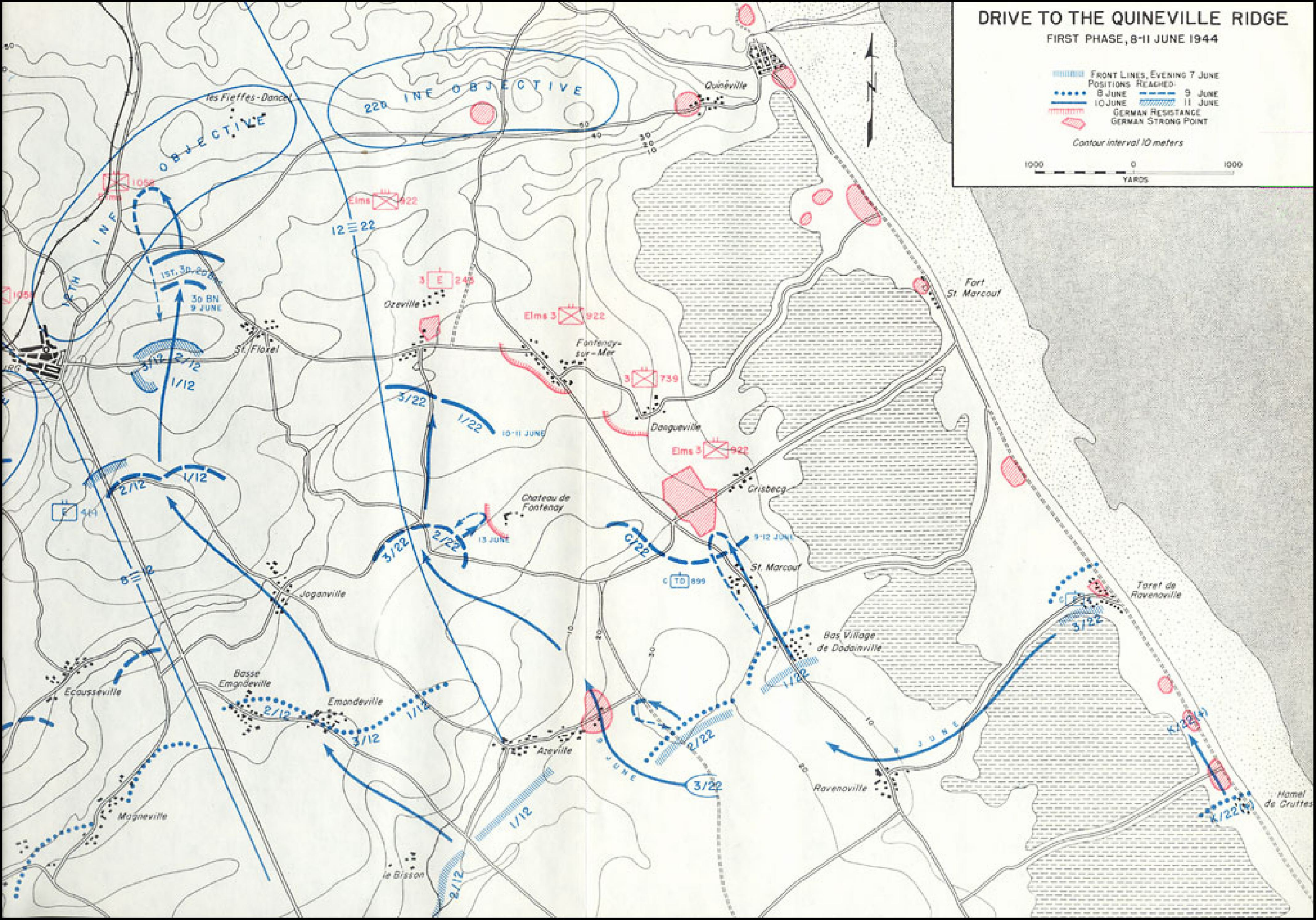


# DRIVE TO THE QUINEVILLE RIDGE
