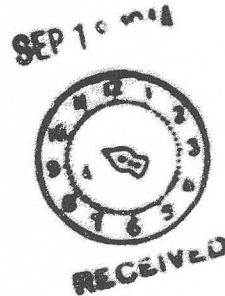

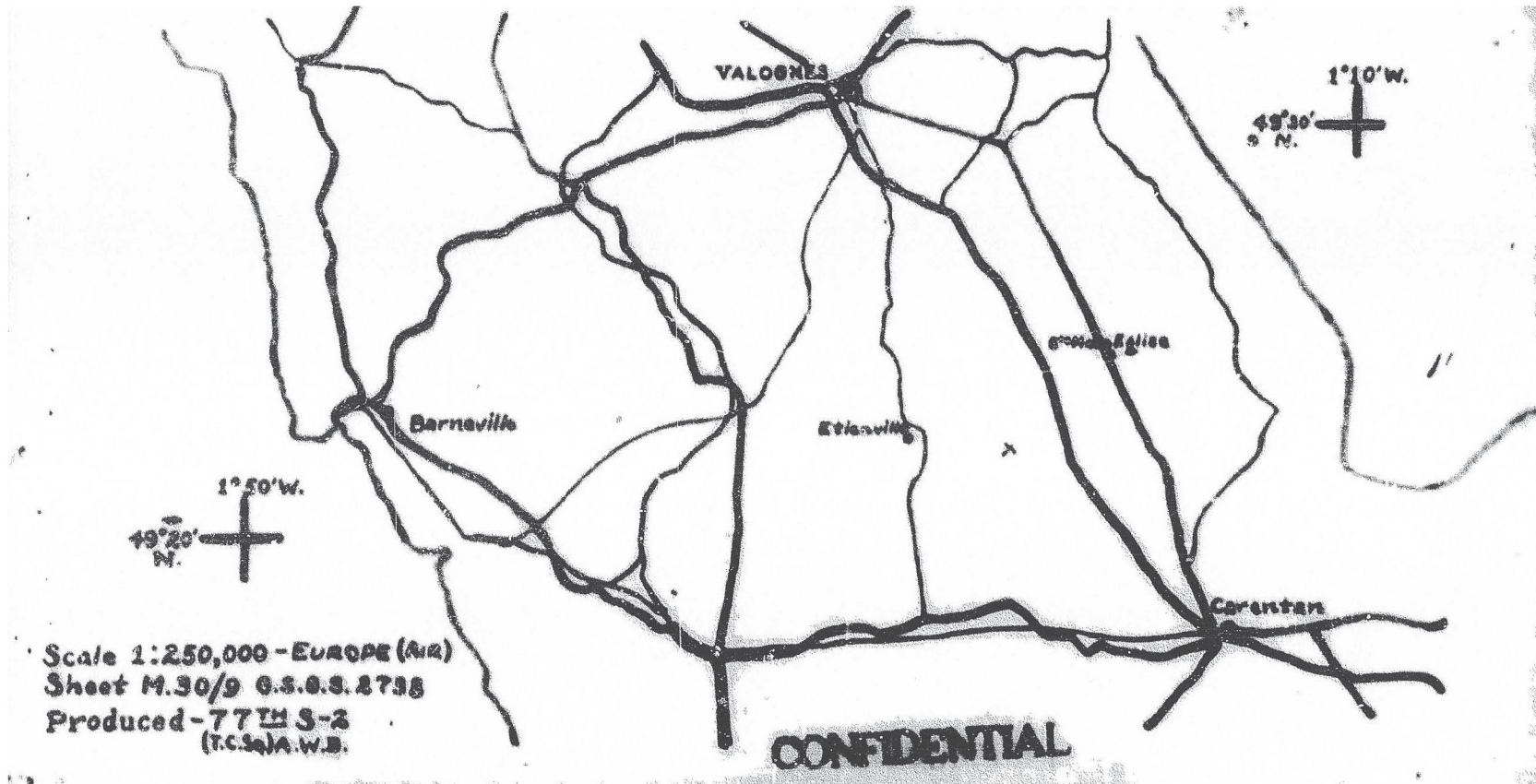

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REPORT OF CREW CHIEF OF B-7 A - No. 43-30720

3 June 1944

Our ship was flying on the right wing of the third flight of the second wave. Lt Hamblin was flying on the left wing of the third flight of the 2nd wave. I was in the rear of the ship waiting for the four a/c to wait when I noticed our lead ship as to let down, at this time we were at approximately 1500 ft.

Visibility was very poor as we started down into the over cast. Lt. Hamblin did not follow the lead ship but continued at 1500 ft.

I did not see his ship after that and I also did not see anyone jump.

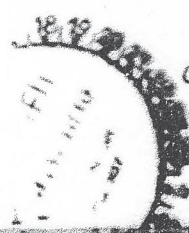


