Military Rites Held in South Dakota for Gene Gaukel

Final military rites were held for Pvt. F.C. Eugene Gaukel, at Brookings, South Dakota, on January 10, 1949, at 2:30 p.m., Father R. Schirber officiating, at the graveside service, with the Townsend-Hoffman American Legion Post in command.

The mortal remains were laid to rest beside his mother and brother, Philip, in Greenwood Cemetery.

Eugene was born at Beroun, Minn. February 14, 1922. When three years of age, moved to Brookings, S. D. with his parents, where he attended the first few years of his school, later moving to Hinckley, Minn., where he attended high school, graduating from the Red Wing high school in 1940.

He entered the Army in October, 1942, and the following Spring joined the paratroopers. He received his training at Fort Benning, Ga. In January, 1944, he was sent to England, and on June 6th, 1944, took part in the D-Day invasion at Normandy. On June 11, 1944, he gave his life for his country.
