RECORD OF EVENTS

29 Dec/44. Remained in secondary defensive positions. Increased EY Arty activity. Large number of allied bombers flying overhead, most of the day. Weather Clear and warmer. Morale Good.

30 Dec/44. Remained in secondary defensive positions. Received increased enemy artillery fire. Inspected Allied Tanks to demonstrate vulnerability of enemy tanks to individuals. Colder and snowing. Morale good. Issued pair of gloves and 1 blanket per man. Issued 10-1 rations.

31 Dec/44. Moved out from secondary positions at 1730 to occupy forward positions. Weather cold and cloudy. Morale Good.
