

6. Supplemental or continuation forms will be prepared and attached to the original forms as necessary.

7. The provisions of A. R. 40-215 respecting the notifications to be given of vaccinations performed and the preparation and disposal of immunization registers will be carefully observed.

8. Record as *vaccina, vaccinoid, or immune reaction*. If there is no reaction, or if the reaction fails to conform to any of the three recognized types, *vaccination will be repeated*. The use of the term "unsuccessful vaccination" on official records is prohibited (par. 2d (4), A. R. 40-215).

9. Record as *positive, positive combined, pseudo-negative, or negative*.



My dear Private Izumi:

I am replying to your letter of September 9, 1944, addressed to General Marshall relative to your desire to be transferred to the Army Air Forces.

It is realized that you are desirous of continuing your aeronautical training. However, in an effort to equalize the youth, intelligence and leadership levels of the three major components of the Army, the War Department has precluded the transfer of members of the Army Ground Forces or Army Service Forces to the Army Air Forces unless the circumstances are very unusual and a qualified replacement is immediately available for transfer from the Army Air Forces. Applications for transfer to the other principal components of the Army are rarely received from Army Air Forces personnel.

I am sure you will understand that the foregoing policy has been established only after full consideration of existing military needs and in an effort to insure an early and victorious conclusion of the War. To attain this goal, I am also sure that you will appreciate the responsibility which rests with every member of the military establishment to perform the duties inherent in his present assignment to the best of his ability.

GENEVIEVE CARTER TELLS CLOSING OF ALL MANZANAR SCHOOLS IN MAY

All schools in the center, including nursery, kindergarten, elementary, secondary and adult education classes, will close on May 29, announced Genevieve W. Carter, superintendent of Education.

She stated that the pre-school has already been forced to close several of its centers because of lack of pre-school teachers.

The superintendent of Education said that the school will, however, continue in the same manner regardless of the approaching close of all education. The schools are planning to have their customary events, including the Senior Play, elementary pageant, spring education exhibit, along with Education Week and the high school choir performance. Graduation exercises for the high school students are scheduled for June 2.

"Children will be held to high standards and there will be no relaxing in the quality of work expected from the school children," Dr. Carter declared.

She added, "There are no plans for summer session school under the Education Section since the Education personnel should complete its work by July 1. The Community Activities Section will probably develop some type of summer program."

She concluded by saying that, "The closing of the Education Section also means that about 50 WRA employees must find new jobs, new homes, and a satisfactory place to which they can 'relocate.'"

Broadcast Kuroki Experiences On Air

Emphasizing that racial discrimination produces "wounds in this war that don't get the Purple Heart," the Army Air Forces Radio Unit dramatized the story of Technical Sergeant Ben Kuroki, Nebraska-born hero of the Eighth Air Force, in a half-hour program which was broadcast on January 19 from New York City's Station WABC over a national hook-up of the Columbia Broadcasting System.

The Air Forces program wove together some of Sergeant Kuroki's experiences and several of the incidents directed against Japanese Americans in various parts of the United States, to drive home the point that "it isn't race or religion that makes free men... but a way of life." Soldiers of the Army Air Forces wrote, directed, and acted on the program. Music was provided by a 50-piece Army Air Forces band.

Early in the program the narrator said it would "tell the story of a boy from a farmhouse near a potato field in Hershey, Neb., who had 'picked up a very fancy collection of decorations, commendations, medals and citations—including two distinguished Flying Crosses, the Air Medal, and four oak leaf clusters, a Presidential citation, and a dozen bronze stars—but no Purple Heart. Which is the point of the story."

Recent incidents were used to emphasize that Japanese Americans should not be discriminated against because of their race in the following and other excerpt from the script:

"Have you heard the story of the boy from Nebraska? He was missed by flak over Germany, but he could get it right in the

Hearing of the cancellation of the Bishop-Manzanar High School game by members of the Bishop High School Board of Trustees, students of Bishop High School unanimously signed a petition asking that the game be played and presented it to the board, the Inyo Register quoted Student Body President Micky Duffy as stating.

A second game scheduled for February 9 at Bishop has not been officially acted on to date, the Register revealed.

The paper stated that one member of the board pointed out that objection to the game being played had been raised and that it was decided to postpone the contest rather than run the risk of community agitation in the matter.

It was disclosed that the school board will be glad to listen to recommendations from all sides in all matters.

"Most eager to play the contest were boys who are leaving the team to join the armed forces," the Register declared.

Student Body President Duffy was quoted as saying, "We have hopes of meeting Manzanar in a future game, and we hope that the Bishop people can control themselves. Perhaps a game closed to the public would be all right if the game can't be public."

Nisei Soldiers Aid In Coal Deliveries

In a letter of Manzanar, Pvt. Stanley Yagi, former resident of this center who is now stationed at Fort Snelling, Minn., disclosed that Japanese American soldiers at the camp had volunteered and sided in coal deliveries to St. Paul and Minneapolis households which faced a cold wave recently.

Pvt. Stanley Yagi's parents are now residing at 36-7-4.

STRINGENT RATIONING SEEN DESPITE AVAILABLE FOOD SUPPLIES IN 1945

In accordance with the direction of Judge Vinson, Economic Stabilization Director, sugar, butter, processed foods and meat will be available in 1945 in smaller quantities and will therefore, be rationed more stringently, the FLIS Press Release disclosed this week.

It stated that the principle objective of the rationing problem is to secure equitable distribution of available supplies of food to all.

The reason leading to the new rationing program, which was introduced at the beginning of this year, are:

SUGAR: Only 78 pounds of sugar per person will be available in 1945. This compares with 85 pounds per person in 1944 and 107 pounds per person in 1941. The shortage of sugar results from a larger civilian consumption than expected in 1944; below average beet sugar production; shipping shortages; diversion of 900,000 tons of sugar to production of industrial alcohol for synthetic rubber and munitions; larger anticipated military requirements in 1945.

BUTTER: The War Food Administration has allocated 12 million less pounds of butter for

Magazine Tells Work Of Nisei Engineers On Italian Front

The work of the volunteer Japanese American Engineers, fighting with frontline Infantrymen in the Fifth Army's drive over the forested mountains of northern Italy, was mentioned in the January 1945, issue of the Military Engineer.

All members of the Engineer company, including the six officers, are Americans of Japanese combat duty from Hawaii and relocation centers in the United States, it said.

The article continued: "When they joined the Fifth Army as fresh troops, they were assigned the main road of advance in their sector—one of the toughest jobs on the front."

"One of their most important jobs is constructing bypasses—emergency run-arounds through stream beds where retreating Germans have blown up bridges. The husky little GI's work furiously along the streams so that infantry and vehicles may move up at the earliest possible moment."

"Their combat record reads like that of the Infantrymen."

"These new hours will permit mess hall attendants, internal security officers and others to attend the shows," stated Wentner. "Doors will open at 6:30 p.m. but will close promptly at 7 p.m. thus permitting one half hour for the audience to assemble and be seated. No one will be permitted to enter after the doors close."

Under the new plan admission will be by dated ticket only and a ticket is valid only on the night indicated by the date on the ticket.

This plan is necessary so that attendance may be limited to 1230 persons permitted under fire regulations.

To prevent congestion at the doors there will be two ticket takers stationed at the two doors and no one will be permitted to enter unless he has a valid ticket, and tickets are required for every person who will occupy a seat, including children.

Under the new plan there will be seats for all and no one will be permitted to stand along the side of the auditorium.

Children Eligible For Relocation Without Escort Of Relatives

Due to the Supreme Court's recent decision on the Endo case, wishing to relocate without being unattached children or children accompanied by or going to responsible relatives cannot be refused permission to leave a center if the War Department has not designated them to be ineligible for relocation, WRA director Dillon S. Myer disclosed in the Post-exclusion Bulletin No. 2.

Myer stated, however, that since the WRA has a moral responsibility to them for proper placement, they and older members of the family should be advised to contact the Welfare Section regarding State laws governing inter-state placement of children.

In order to qualify for relocation assistance, they must have the approved relocation plans and should not be urged to leave the center until such plans are developed because of their dependency status.

All evacuees desiring to travel to Hawaii or Alaska should hereafter submit their requests to the Japanese American Branch, Office of the Provost Marshal General, Presidio, San Francisco, Calif.

File Injunction Suit

OGDEN, Utah—An injunction suit was filed this week against the Ogden, Utah, city commission by George Sugihara and Mrs. Verda Hulse, co-proprietors of the Green Parrott cafe, to test the city commission's policy of refusing to grant business licenses to persons of Japanese ancestry who were not in business in the city prior to Pearl Harbor.






