Solemn requiem high mass for Sgt. William R. Bopp of 337 Juncunda St., Knoxville, will be sung at 10 a. m. tomorrow at St. Canice's Church.

Sgt. Bopp was killed in action in Belgium on Dec. 30, 1944, while serving with Co. C of the 101st Airborne Engineers.

He attended St. Canice's and the South Hills

High Schools and at the time he entered service was employed by the Pennsylvania Railroad.
