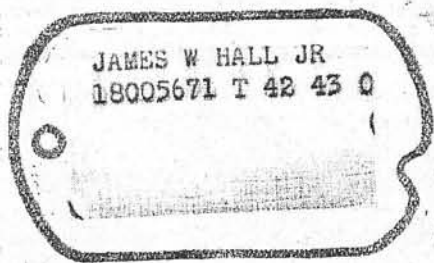

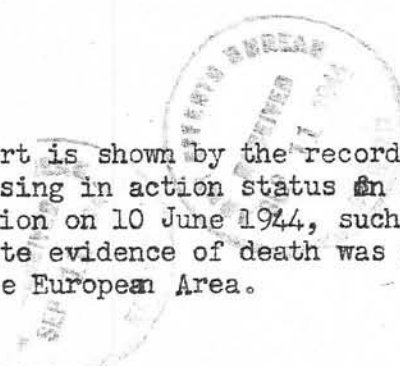

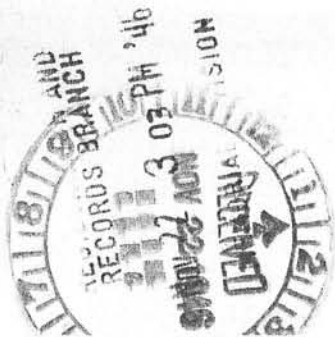

We have your letter of January 29th wherein you have asked for an application blank to be completed for the return of your son, James W. Hall, Jr.

We are aware that your request for this form is based on a recent newspaper article which appeared in your Dallas newspapers. It is deeply regretted that the article stated that application blanks were available at this office as this is not the case. In a few days your Dallas newspapers will carry a correct version of what information is available at this office and why we are desirous of placing it in the hands of next of kin. The only time that it will be necessary for you to inform the War Department as to your wishes regarding the return and reburial of your son will be when the branch of service of which he was a member sends you a letter with the necessary form and specifically asks for your desires. Should you desire to relinquish your rights to the next in line of kinship, please complete Part II of the enclosed form. If you are not the next of kin, please complete Part III of the enclosed form.

If you should elect Option 2, it is advised that no funeral arrangements or other personal arrangements be made until you are further notified by this office.

Will you please complete the enclosed form, "Request for Disposition of Remains" and mail in the enclosed self-addressed envelope, which requires no postage, within 30 days after its receipt by you? Its prompt return will avoid unnecessary delays.
