



Reference is made to that portion of your letter in which you request the personal effects, and burial location of the remains of Private James D. Hogue.

A copy of your letter has been forwarded to the Effects Quartermaster, Army Effects Bureau, Kansas City Quartermaster Depot, 601 Hardesty Avenue, Kansas City 1, Missouri, for reply to you. That office has jurisdiction over the disposal of the personal effects of our military personnel who die outside the United States. However, considerable time is often necessary to process these personal belongings back to this country due to the lack of shipping space and the great amount of work involved.

I fully understand your desire to obtain information relative to the place of burial of Private Hogue's remains, and I regret to inform you that up to the present time this information has not been received. Sometimes months elapse before information of this nature is received which delay I feel sure you will understand when you consider the existing conditions under which it must be obtained. However, you may be sure that upon receipt of such information in this office you will be advised.

Reference is made to that portion of your letter in which you request the personal effects, and burial location of the remains of Private James D. Hogue.

A copy of your letter has been forwarded to the Effects Quartermaster, Army Effects Bureau, Kansas City Quartermaster Depot, 601 Hardesty Avenue, Kansas City 1, Missouri, for reply to you. That office has jurisdiction over the disposal of the personal effects of our military personnel who die outside the United States. However, considerable time is often necessary to process these personal belongings back to this country due to the lack of shipping space and the great amount of work involved.

I fully understand your desire to obtain information relative to the place of burial of Private Hogue's remains, and I regret to inform you that up to the present time this information has not been received. Sometimes months elapse before information of this nature is received which delay I feel sure you will understand when you consider the existing conditions under which it must be obtained. However, you may be sure that upon receipt of such information in this office you will be advised.

The Adjutant General's Office is charged with the responsibility of furnishing information concerning the circumstances surrounding the death of our soldiers. I am sending another copy of your letter to that office in order that you may be informed regarding your request.

According to the records of this office the decedent named Mr. John E. Hogue, Gordon, Georgia, as his father. In your letter to this office you refer to the decedent as your nephew. Please advise us of the correct relationship.
