This responds to your letter dated May 21, 1989, concerning the place of burial of Ernest King and Luigi Albarelli.

This command has an alphabetical listing of American service members who died overseas during World War II. The term "died overseas" includes those individuals who were listed in a missing status and declared dead. The name of Luigi Albarelli is not on our listing. We must assume that he survived the war.

We found eight Ernest Kings on our listing. We eliminated six names from consideration for various reasons including branch of service and place of death. The other two are buried in New Jersey and New York respectively. We eliminated the one buried in New Jersey because he was killed in Italy.

Corporal Ernest J. King, 6 903 117, is buried in Long Island National Cemetery, Farmingdale, New York 11735. Enclosed are copies of documents in his individual deceased personnel file that pertain to his death and the disposition of his remains. We do not have further information about him. His personnel records are under the jurisdiction of the National Personnel Records Center, 9700 Page Boulevard, St. Louis, Missouri 63132.

I hope the above information and the enclosed documents are helpful.



This indicates that they survived the war or served under a different spelling of their names. If you can provide us with additional information, such as serial numbers, we will be happy to search these records again.
