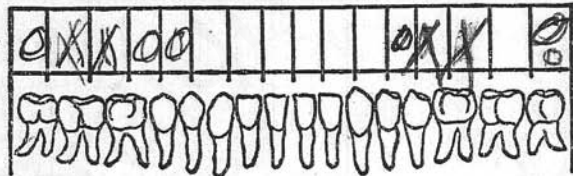

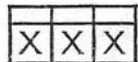

Remains received after being processed and wrapped and casketed at casketing point St-Laurent. No clothing was received with remains as they were destroyed at casketing point. In accordance with O.I.#19, Ex.h.O#771, the remains of Pvt TILLET, George E, were brought together and examined with those of Unk X-89 USMC Blosville T-1-9. The examination revealed that Pvt TILLET and Unk X-89 were one and the same remains - and that consolidation could be made - Unk X-89 was consolidated with Pvt TILLET USMC La Combe -EE-5-88 and grave T-1-9 USMC Blosville was declared an open grave.

A mandible with teeth set there in was recovered. Teeth charted and chart attached. As per instructions in inclosure to Ex.h.O#771, these teeth were examined. Examination revealed that the teeth did not compare with dental chart on OQMG Form 371. As per instructions, this mandible was removed from remains of Pvt TILLET and kept with the remains of Unk X-450 USMC, La Combe France. This making two mandibles with X-450 and leaving a part of mandible with TILLET, but no teeth are with this mandible. The remains were left at casketing point St-Laurent, France

INFORMATION CIRCULAR CONCERNING THE PERSONAL EFFECTS OF
DECEASED MILITARY PERSONNEL

1. The Army Effects Bureau, Kansas City, Missouri, has been established by the War Department to receive and dispose of the personal effects of military personnel who die outside the continental limits of the United States.

2. Due to hazards of the sea and the many difficulties in transportation of property from overseas, it is impossible to determine accurately when effects will arrive here. However, this circular has been prepared to furnish approximate information regarding the time which may elapse. The following will serve as a guide as to the time that normally is required for effects to reach this Bureau from the various theaters of operations:

EUROPEAN THEATER

Six months.

NORTH AFRICAN THEATER (INCLUDING ITALY)

Six months.

ASIATIC AND SOUTHWEST PACIFIC THEATERS

From ten to twelve months.

3. It is necessary that this Bureau have the following information to enable disposition of the soldier's personal effects, according to existing regulations:

- (a) The name and address of his widow, if he was married.
- (b) The names and addresses of his parents.
- (c) In the event an executor or administrator of the soldier's estate has been appointed by the probate court, the original or a certified copy of the Letters Testamentary or Letters of Administration should be forwarded to the Army Effects Bureau, for inspection. If original papers are submitted, they will be returned promptly.

4. It is advisable that the next-of-kin inform this Bureau of any change in address.
